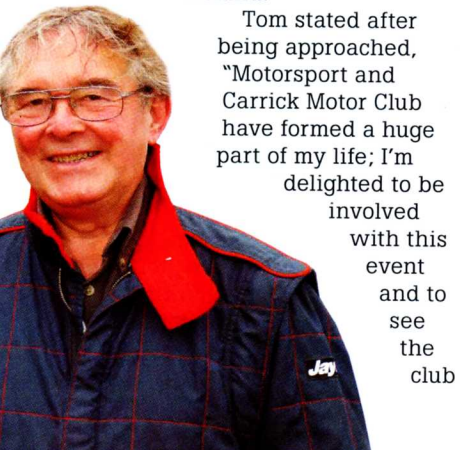




November RallySprint set for Waterford Airport
