

## Breen weighs up more International outings

Craig Breen is considering a full assault on the Fiesta Sport Trophy International after claiming a debut victory in the series in Portugal last weekend.

Breen, 19, had only planned to tackle the Algarve-based event to increase his experience of the one-make discipline. But he ended up claiming maximum points and a further 12 bonus points for stages won.

It means he enjoys a 16-point advantage over German Patrick Anglade, who finished second.

"We'll decide what we're going to do this week," said the Irishman. "After the start we've made it would be foolish not to look at doing more events. Portugal was very much a one-off in terms of the International series and, as things stand, there are no plans to compete in Sardinia [where the series resumes next month]."

Breen will return to asphalt for this weekend's Circuit of Ireland, the first time he has tackled the Irish Tarmac qualifier.
