**WORLD Rally Academy champion Craig Breen staged a remarkable recovery from a broken driveshaft on his Sainteloc Peugeot 207 on Thursday, to finish sixth last night in the gruelling Tour de Corse, the fourth round of the Intercontinental Rally Challenge.**

The Waterford driver had to limp slowly through two of the stages, dropping to 23rd place that night, but a fine drive throughout the remaining two days lifted him back on to the leaderboard.
